

Standard doors are up to 2040mm high and 926mm wide. Bespoke door leaves can be manufactured up to 2400mm high and 950mm wide. Fire doors are available in 44mm (FD30 doors) and 54mm (FD60 doors) depth.

Deanta doorsets include high quality door frames consisting of a hardwood, softwood or MDF core with an oak veneer, walnut veneer or white primed finish, to complement your choice of door.


WIRED GLAZING CLEAR GLAZING






ORDERING


DELIVERY

Deanta operate a fleet of vehicles across the UK providing a flexible delivery service. Deliveries are made direct to site or to our stockists on curtain-side vehicles suitable for forklift offloading.



STORAGE

Doorsets are a second fix product and should be stored horizontally, off the floor on a flat and level surface within a clean and dry environment. Doors should be protected from direct heat, humid conditions and moisture. Doors should not be stored in storage containers or any unheated space.



INSTALLATION

Doorsets must not be fitted in a house that is freshly plastered and doorsets should only be delivered to site after all wet trades are finished and the area is sufficiently dried. Doors should be acclimatised within the dwelling 7 days before installation.



WARRANTIES

A ten year warranty applies to our doors for manufacturing faults. A ten year warranty applies to our ironmongery (handles and locks) for mechanical faults.
